## CONSULATE GENERAL OF DENMARK IN NEW YORK

Invest in Denmark is the national investment promotion agency of Denmark. Through active, focused marketing efforts in North America, Asia and Europe, the organization assists foreign companies with an interest in establishing activities in Denmark.

Invest in Denmark employs more than 60 people across the world. The North American team has 10 employees who are based in New York, Silicon Valley and Toronto. The office in New York consists of a Regional Director, 4 investment managers and 1 intern.

The position as an intern at Invest in Denmark is for a period of 6 months starting from **August 1** for the autumn semester and **February 1** for the spring semester. The successful applicant will join a team of experienced colleagues with backgrounds in investment promotion in North America. As an intern, you will be responsible for a number of different assignments within the field of ICT, Cleantech and Life Sciences.

### Job responsibilities:

- Focused market research
- Research on American companies' core competencies
- Assisting investment managers in the areas of Life Sciences, Cleantech and ICT
- Project management of specific events and activities
- Assisting in developing business intelligence
- Preparing presentations, updating databases and other administrative tasks

### Academic qualifications:

- You have a Bachelor degree and you are currently studying a relevant Master program
- Commercial and/or economic background and a good understanding of business environments
- Strong analytical skills
- Understanding of Danish core competencies and framework conditions

The most important task will be to take part in our investment team. Applicants should have good interpersonal skills. We therefore expect you to be a team-player and possess a great deal of initiative. Invest in Denmark is looking for an extrovert and independent candidate with a high drive, and a person who is capable of delivering within deadlines. Fluency in English and Danish, both written and spoken, is a prerequisite. The internship is unpaid.
